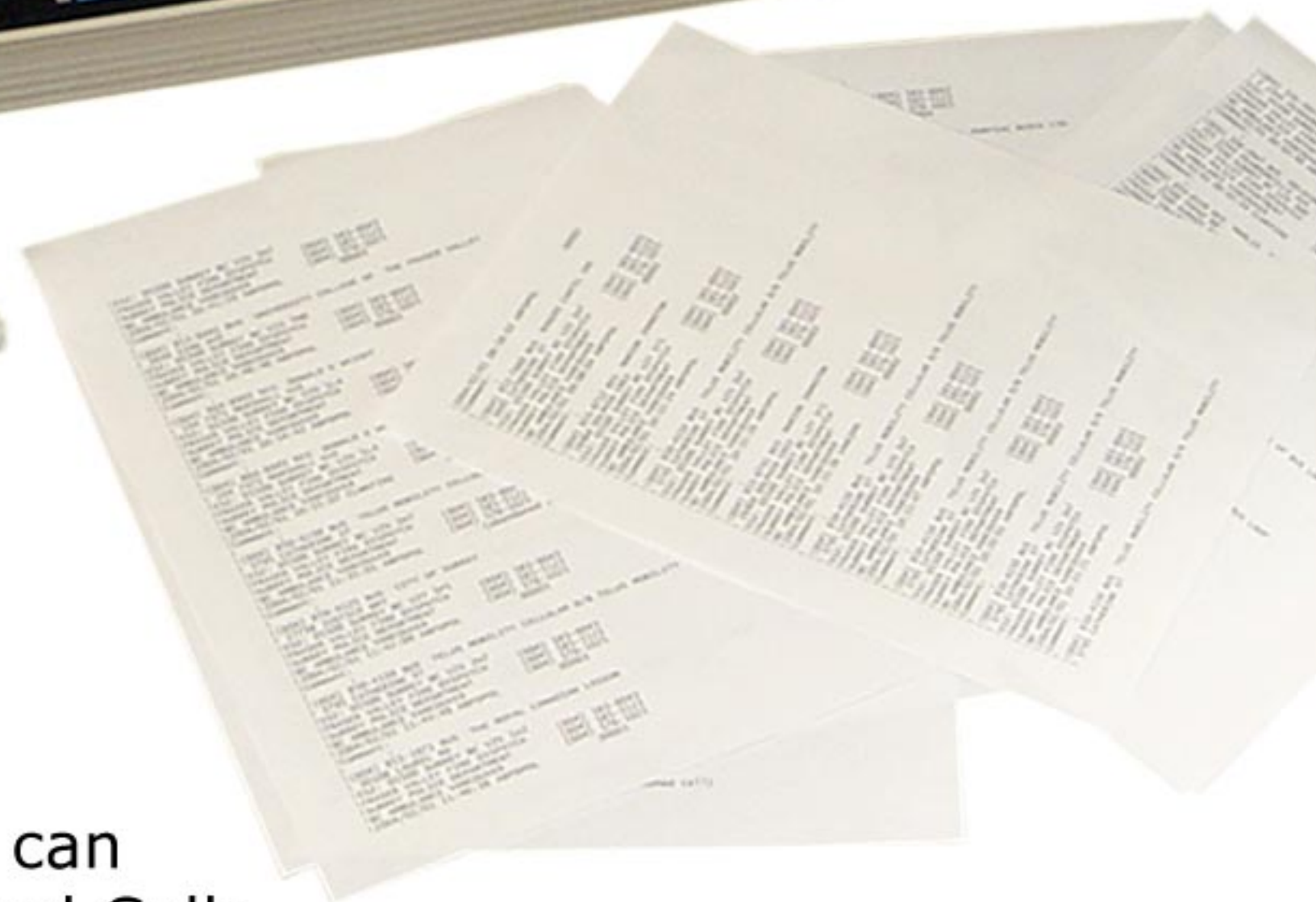


GenWatch

Your 911 System watchman from Genesis...

GenWatch collects and displays critical 911 call information received directly from your 911 system. The information is displayed in real-time on your computer's screen. Immediate reports can be printed for easy follow-up.



GenWatch's alarms can alert you to Abandoned Calls or to specific callers, when they happen. Alarm reports can be printed automatically. Strobe lights or other devices can also be activated.

GenWatch is very simple to use. In 911 centers time is critical. Your 911 operators are too busy to learn how to use new software packages or wade through complex screens and menus just to get that critical 911 call information. With **GenWatch** that is never a problem. Simplicity is the whole concept behind **GenWatch**.



GenWatch is the perfect running partner of **Genesis 911**. **GenWatch** is designed for immediate easy access to 911 caller's information for instant follow-up or action, on a call by call basis. **Genesis 911** produces a full compliment of management and statistical reports that are critical for managing your 911 emergency centre. With these two complimenting packages you have complete control over your 911 emergency centre.

How does GenWatch work?

GenWatch connects to the serial data port(s) of your 911 controller. Typically it would connect to the Real-time and Log printer ports.

GenWatch collects the call information from both ports making it available for immediate reporting. You can switch between viewing the Real-time and Log printer information at the click of a button.

Alarm triggers can be defined by you (like Abandoned or No ANI Calls). When call information matching your alarm triggers is received, your computer sounds an alarm and the information is automatically printed on your printer. External strobes or other devices can also be activated. You decide the action to be taken!

Keep as much call information as you like, or have **GenWatch** automatically purge old call information for you. Print history on previous calls at any time.
